Kielce Technology Park organized an international conference on the discussed issues of dual education: practical and vocational training. The event began with the official opening by the Director of the Kielce Technology Park - Szymon Mazurkiewicz and Deputy President of the City of Kielce - Tadeusz Saylor. Representatives of the Board of Education in Kielce showed how the system of vocational education look in the region.

The next step during the meeting was the presentation of good practices by representatives of each of the partner countries and a brief overview of examples of practical training centers in the country and the region. Examples of Poland were presented by representatives of the Świętokrzyskie In-Service Teacher Training Centre in Kielce.

The first panel discussion was a summary of the current presentations. The panel was attended by people presenting before good examples in their countries. After a short break there was time to introduce to the discuss about the competition of the future. The presentation prepared by Wiktor Krasa, a doctor at the University "Higher School of Economics, Law and Medical Sciences in Kielce."
